Year 2 History Trip to The SS Great Britain

On Wednesday 14th January, Year 2 children will be visiting The SS Great Britain in Bristol. As part of the visit, they will have the opportunity to visit the SS Great Britain ship and take part in an interactive workshop 'Victorians at Sea' to learn about what life was like on board.
