- Revision of division and multiplication, addition and subtraction methods.

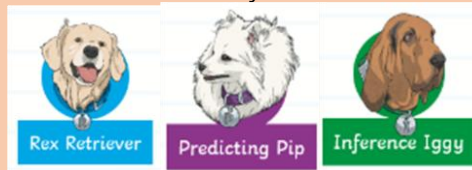
Reading
